



## SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE APPLICATION FORM

The Moody Foundation recognizes that some families may not have the means to cover the cost of extracurricular activities for children. The Moody Foundation has, therefore, established a Scholarship Fund for the purpose of helping to pay these fees for those in need of such assistance. Applicants must be residents of Midland County.

### Terms & Conditions:

- Proof of annual household income is required by attaching one of the following: A copy of your most recent Federal 1040 tax form or government assistance 1099. Please make sure to include all sources of income, including wages, government or community assistance, child support, as well as any other scholarships. We require that you meet the “low income” standard set by MSHDA. For 2024, Midland County is \$52,950 annual household income.
- Scholarship funds are limited and, therefore, eligibility does not guarantee any dollar amount of funding or even of funding itself. Depending on annual household income, household size, and/or special circumstances, scholarships may cover from 25% - 100% of the requested amount.
- A Scholarship Committee is responsible for allocating funds in a fair and balanced way that serves the largest possible number of eligible applicants. Limits may be placed on dollar amounts granted per family.
- Please include with your completed scholarship application:
  - Registration form for the activity
  - Receipts for equipment to show costs supporting your request
  - Proof of income for all those living in your household.
- These should be mailed or emailed to The Moody Foundation. Please allow up to four weeks to review your application prior to any deadline when the funds are needed. Please be sure to include your phone number and email so we can contact you. All information you share is kept confidential.

## The Moody Foundation Scholarship Application

The Moody Foundation understands that many families in Midland County may face financial barriers that prevent their children from participating in extracurricular activities. To support these families, the Foundation has established a Scholarship Fund to assist with the costs of these activities.

### Eligibility:

- Applicants must be **residents of Midland County, MI**.
- Applicants must meet the **“low-income” standards** set by the Michigan State Housing Development Authority (MSHDA) for 2024, with the maximum allowable annual household income for Midland County being **\$52,950**.

### Terms & Conditions:

#### 1. Proof of Income:

- To apply, applicants must provide **proof of annual household income**. This can be done by submitting one of the following:
  - A **copy of the most recent Federal 1040 tax form**, or
  - A **1099 form** for any government assistance received.
- All sources of household income must be documented, including wages, government assistance, child support, scholarships, and other community support.

#### 2. Funding Availability:

- Scholarship funds are limited, and eligibility **does not guarantee a specific dollar amount** of assistance.
- Depending on your household income, size, and special circumstances, awards can cover **25% to 100%** of the requested funding.

#### 3. Scholarship Committee Review:

- A **Scholarship Committee** will review applications and allocate funds in a fair and equitable manner. The goal is to assist as many eligible applicants as possible.
- The Committee may impose limits on the amount of funding granted to each family.

#### 4. Required Documentation:

- Along with your completed scholarship application, please submit the following:

- A **registration form** for the extracurricular activity.
  - **Receipts or estimates** for any equipment required for participation.
  - **Proof of income** for all household members.
5. Please ensure that all required documents are sent by **mail** or **email** to The Moody Foundation.

**Important Information:**

- Please allow up to **four weeks** for the review of your application, especially if the requested funds are needed by a specific deadline.
- **Contact Information:** Be sure to include your **phone number** and **email address** with your application so we can contact you if needed.
- **Confidentiality:** All information submitted will be treated with the utmost confidentiality.
